Unexploded Ordnance (UXO) Site Specific Safety Package

Equip site supervisors to manage and brief personnel about UXO risks

All personnel involved in intrusive ground works should attend a UXO Awareness Briefing before starting operations. This is an essential part of a site UXO Risk Mitigation Plan.

Briefings are designed to give ground staff a background to the UXO risk on and in the area of a site, what to look out for, and what to do in the event that a suspect item is encountered.

In the first instance this should be delivered by a qualified UXO Specialist. However, for longer term projects on 'Low' risk sites or where it may not be a requirement for an UXO Specialist to be present on site at all times – we offer a Site Specific Safety Package (SSSP) which allow a contractor's representative to deliver the briefings to other staff members.

Aimed at site / project management / supervisory staff, a SSSP is delivered by an experienced UXO Specialist Trainer. We deliver the training as a 3/4 hour presentation and toolbox talk, which includes information specific to the UXO risk on the site in question – and details of how this can be managed.

What is included in a SSSP?

The content of the SSSP will include:

- The common physical characteristics of UXO.
- The effect that site works might have on the different varieties of UXO.
- Actions to take in the event of a suspected UXO discovery.
- How to deliver a UXO Awareness Briefing to other operatives.
- How to manage and mitigate UXO risk.

Following the presentation, the UXO Specialist Trainer will provide a briefing pack in both hard copy and digital format. The pack includes information about identifying and reporting suspicious UXO discoveries, with pictures to assist with the identification process and posters which can be printed and displayed on-site to raise awareness with other staff.
